



The Association Annual Membership Meeting will be held this year on August 8, 2026, at the Stars and Strikes Bowling Center located on Whiteman AFB. The meeting will start at 11:00 am and our usual No-Tap tournament starting at the conclusion of the meeting.

This meeting is your opportunity to have a say in how your association is run. Up for election this season will be the following positions: President, 1st Vice President, and 3 incumbent Director slots. We will be awarding 2 youth scholarships, one possible Hall of Fame inductee, and 4 bowlers of the year (one male, one female, one youth male, and one youth female). Paid memberships for the 2026-2027 season will be raffled off as door prizes (1 in 5 ratio will be awarded).

In order to expedite entrance onto Whiteman AFB, please contact Association Manager Ronald Soqui for information on getting pre-approved for a base pass for the day. A list of persons asking for pre-approval must be submitted no later than July 16, 2026 to complete back ground checks. Any members not on the pre-approval list will have to be signed on base on the day of the meeting, a process than can take up to 30-45 minutes to be accomplished. Please plan accordingly.

The No-Tap tournament is open to all bowlers holding a 2025-2026 USBC membership. Cost will be \$20 per bowler with \$7.50 going to lineage and \$12.50 to the prize fund. Tournament rules are on the reverse side of this notice.

No-Tap Tournament Rules

1. This Tournament is non sanctioned but will be governed by the USBC rule book and is open to all members holding a 2025-2026 USBC membership.
2. Tournament will consist of both 8-pin no-tap and 9-pin no-tap format. All bowlers with an average of 150 and below will use 8-pin format and all bowlers with an average of 151 and above will use 9-pin format. Averages will be confirmed by the Association manager.
3. Any bowler under the age of 18 who qualifies for any prize will have their prize submitted to their individual SMART account. In the event there are 10 or more youth bowlers entered, a separate youth division will be formed.
